	>>The Embassy of Japan will select preliminary candidates from among applicants by reviewing the submitted documents.
By March 1 (Thu)	Details of the written examination will be announced to the applicants who passed the first selection.
March 6 (Tue)	The written examination will take place at the Embassy of Japan from 14:00 to 16:00. All applicants should take the examination of Japanese.
By March 7 (Wed)	Details of the interview will be announced to successful candidates on the basis of written exam.
March 13 (Tue)	The interview will take place at the Embassy.
By March 15 (Thu)	Announcement of the final result of the candidate(s) selection in Slovenia.  >>Successful candidate(s) will be asked to submit the Medical certificate and other document(s) to the Embassy of Japan if necessary.
March 20 (Tue)	Deadline for submitting additional document(s) to the Embassy of Japan.
By end of July	Screening by the Japanese government.  Japanese Government will notify the Embassy of Japan in Slovenia of its final selection of the candidates. The Embassy will notify the candidates of the result.
October	The selected student is to leave for Japan and commence the study with scholarship.
